M-1 Garand/M1A Match (per CMP rules) - 100 yards, 5 sighters in 5 minutes, 10 shots slow fire prone in 10 minutes, 10 shots rapid fire prone in 80 seconds, 10 shots slow fire standing in 10 minutes.

Smallbore Prone Matches (per NRA rules) - 100 yards, 1 match any sight, 1 match metallic sight, 40 shots per match,

Highpower Rifle Matches (per NRA rules) - 100 yards, 10 shots slow fire standing in 10 minutes, 10 shots rapid fire sitting in 60 seconds, 10 shots rapid fire prone in 70 seconds, 20 shots slow fire prone in 20 minutes.

Pistol Matches - 25 yards, 10 shots slow fire in 10 minutes, 10 shots timed fire (2 groups of 5 shots in 20 seconds), 10 shots rapid fire (2 groups of 5 shots in 10 seconds). This course of fire is shot 3 times, once with a .22 rimfire, once with any centerfire, and once with an M1911 .45 cal handgun.

NOTICE: Due to the response, we have modified the clubhouse cleaning policy. To allow everyone an opportunity, members are limited to two months a year unless no other members are interested. Plus, these months may not be consecutive (again unless no one else is interested). If you have any questions, please contact a board member.
