The AR-15 was first built by ArmaLite as a select fire rifle for the US armed forces. Due to financial problems, ArmaLite sold the AR-15 design to Colt. Colt started selling the semi-automatic version as the Colt AR-15 for civilian sales in 1963. Although "AR-15" remains a Colt registered trademark, variants of the firearm are made, modified and sold under various names by multiple manufacturers.
