ELIGIBILITY: ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE PAID-UP MEMBERS OF THE OHIO RIFLE & PISTOL ASSOCIATION OR BELONG TO THE STATE ASSOCIATION IN WHICH THEY RESIDE.

RULES: CURRENT NRA RULES WILL GOVERN; RULE 3.3.1 NRA ANY SIGHT MATCH RIFLE, WILL BE USED. YOU MAY USE ANY NRA MATCH RIFLE (3.3) WITH NO RESTRICTIONS ON SIGHTS. YOUR SCORE WILL NOT BE SENT IN TO NRA FOR CLASSIFICATION OR NATIONAL RECORDS. YOU WILL COMPETE WITHIN YOUR OWN GROUP AND WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR AWARDS IN THEIR DIVISION.

ENTRIES: ENTRIES IN INDIVIDUAL EVENTS WILL BE MADE BY USING THE ENCLOSED ENTRY CARD ACCOMPANIED BY CHECK OR MONEY ORDER (NO CREDIT CARDS) MADE PAYABLE TO THE OHIO RIFLE & PISTOL ASSOCIATION. BE SURE TO INDICATE YOUR CORRECT NRA CLASSIFICATION, NRA MEMBERSHIP NUMBER, CATEGORY AND WHETHER YOU WILL BE USING A MATCH OR SERVICE RIFLE.

MAIL ENTRIES IN EARLY - NO LATER THAN FRIDAY OF WEEK PRIOR TO THE MATCH DATE.

AN O.R.P.A. RELEASE FROM LIABILITY MUST BE ON FILE FOR EVERY INDIVIDUAL ON THE RANGE - FAMILY MEMBERS, FRIENDS, AND VOLUNTEERS. ONLY ONE FOR EACH PERSON IS EVER NEEDED.

SQUADDING AND SCORE CARDS: NRA CLASSIFICATION CARD AND STATE ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST BE PRESENTED WHEN PICKING UP SCORE CARDS AT THE STAT OFFICE (BUILDING 1024 C) BEFORE TARGET ASSIGNMENT (SQUADDING). REQUESTS FOR SPECIAL SQUADDING - SHARING EQUIPMENT (ALTERNATE RELAYS - DIFFERENT TARGETS - ADJACENT) SHOULD BE MADE AT TIME OF SQUADDING.

SQUADDING CLOSES ONE HALF-HOUR PRIOR TO PITS BEING SEALED EACH DAY - 7:15 A.M.
PITS WILL BE SEALED 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO SCHEDULED FIRING TIME EACH DAY - 7:45 A.M.
CAMP PERRY S.O.P. STATES THAT FIRING MUST BE COMPLETED BY 5:00 P.M. - NO EXCEPTIONS.

STAT OFFICE HOURS: STAT OFFICE WILL BE OPEN 7:30 PM TO 8:30 PM FRIDAY EVENING.
STAT OFFICE WILL BE OPEN AT 6 AM DURING EACH DAY OF FIRING.

PLEASE PREREGISTER - NO PENALTY FOR NO SHOW!

MAIL EARLY BY FRIDAY OF WEEK BEFORE OR CALL AHEAD NO LATER THAN 5 PM TUESDAY OF MATCH WEEK.

AN NRA EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI) MUST BE IN PLACE IN ALL RIFLES AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT DURING PREP PERIOD AND WHEN BEING FIRED ON THE RANGE!
EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS COST \$1.00 EACH AT THE STAT OFFICE.

CHALLENGES: A CHALLENGE FEE OF \$3.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR EACH CHALLENGE MADE.
SEE NRA RULES FOR CORRECT PROCEDURE.

CLASSIFICATION: THE NRA CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM WILL BE USED IN ALL MATCHES. INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN CLASSIFIED WILL FIRE IN THE MASTER UNCLASSIFIED CLASS. RULE 19.6, ASSIGNED CLASSIFICATION MAY BE USED. THE CATEGORY WITHIN CLASSIFICATION WILL BE CIVILIAN. THE SERVICE CATEGORY (MILITARY) WILL BE ADDED SHOULD THERE BE ENOUGH SERVICE PERSONNEL (5 OR MORE IN A CATEGORY).

EYE PROTECTION AND EAR PROTECTION ARE A MUST ON THE RANGES AND IN THE PITS AT CAMP PERRY.
SAFETY IS NON NEGOTIABLE.

CHANGES IN SCHEDULE WILL BE POSTED AT THE STAT OFFICE AND/OR ANNOUNCED ON THE LINE BY THE CHIEF RANGE OFFICER.

SCOPED RIFLES WILL BE PERMITTED IN INDIVIDUAL MATCHES ON SATURDAY MAY 26 AND SATURDAY JUNE 27 AT A SLIGHTLY REDUCED ENTRY FEE. CLASS AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN AS IN THIS GENERAL INFORMATION. ONLY ONE HIGH OVERALL AWARD. COMPETITORS MUST TURN IN COMPLETED SCORE CARDS WHEN CALLED FOR ON THE LINE.

POSTED SCORES: IT IS THE COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK SCORES AND STANDING ON THE BULLETIN SHEET AND INFORM THE STAT OFFICER OF ANY POSSIBLE ERRORS. AT THE END OF THE MATCHES, SCORES LISTED ON THE BULLETIN SHEET AND WINNER INDICATED IN EACH MATCH WILL BE ACCEPTED AS TRUE AND CORRECT BY THE STAT OFFICER AND THE BULLETIN AND AWARDS WILL BE ISSUED ACCORDINGLY.

MATCH RESULTS: A BULLETIN CONTAINING ALL MATCH RESULTS WILL BE SENT TO ALL PARTICIPANTS.

SCORING & PIT OPERATION: COMPETITORS WILL SCORE AND OPERATE TARGETS IN THE PITS. THEY WILL BE ASSIGNED FOR THIS DUTY AS WELL AS FOR FIRING. IT IS EACH COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO DO THEIR PIT DUTY. PAID PIT PULLERS ARE ALLOWED FOR DISABLED PERSONS ONLY. THE SUBSTITUTE TARGET PULLER MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE STAT OFFICE FOR APPROVAL. THE SUBSTITUTE MUST CHECK IN WITH THE PIT OFFICER. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE MATCHES AND FORFEITURE OF ALL FEES AND AWARDS. ABLE BODIED COMPETITORS MUST PULL THEIR OWN PIT DUTY.

RAPID FIRE TARGETS WILL BE IN THE AIR A MAXIMUM OF THREE MINUTES FOR RECORDING OF SCORES AND GROUPS UNLESS UNDER CONTENTION.

STAGE 1 SLOW FIRE, 200 YARDS, 10 SHOTS STANDING, ONE MINUTE PER SHOT
STAGE 2 RAPID FIRE, 200 YARDS, 10 SHOTS SITTING OR KNEELING FROM STANDING, 60 SECONDS, FIRING TIME
STAGE 3 RAPID FIRE, 300 YARDS, 10 SHOTS PRONE FROM STANDING, 70 SECONDS
STAGE 4 SLOW FIRE, 600 YARDS, 20 SHOTS PRONE, ONE MINUTE PER SHOT

TARGETS: THE MILITARY TARGETS SR WILL BE USED AT 200 YARDS, SR 3 AT 300 YARDS, AND MR 1 AT 600 YARDS.

AMMUNITION MAY BE COMMERCIALY MANUFACTURED OR HANDLOADS. PROJECTILE WILL BE A FULL METAL JACKET WITH A POINTED TIP. NO FLAT TIP OR ROUND NOSE. THE PROJECTILE MAY HAVE A "BALLISTIC" HOLLOW POINT SUCH AS THAT USED IN THE CURRENT MILITARY M852 STYLE, 168 GRAIN, 7.62mm ARSENAL MATCH ROUND. THESE GUIDLINES WILL APPLY TO ALL AUTHORIZED SERVICE RIFLE CALIBERS, I.E., 7.62 mm (.308), 5.56 mm, AND CALIBER .30 (30-06). THERE WILL BE NO RESTRICTIONS PLACED ON BULLET WEIGHT OR MUZZLE VELOCITY.

THE MAJOR ITEM CONSIDERED TO BE OF PARAMOUNT IMPORTANCE IS SAFETY.

ALL AMMUNITION MUST BE SAFE TO SHOOT. REMEMBER - SAFETY IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EVERYONE. NONE OF US WISH TO ENDANGER OURSELVES OR OTHER COMPETITORS ON THE LINE. THERE IS A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF INTEGRITY FOR THE COMPETITOR WHEN FIRING IN A C M P EXCELLENCE-IN-COMPETITION "LEG" MATCH.
