Highpower is 4 Position, 40 Rounds + Sighters. 22 RF Any Sight is 40 Rounds Prone + Sighters. 25 Yd Pistol is .22 and center fire, slow fire, Timed fire, and Rapid fire, 10 Rounds in each.
