Notes on the History of New Carlisle Sportsmen's Club

Introduction

The New Carlisle Sportsmen's Club is in its 50th year of existence. The purpose of this record is to capture evidence of the Club's history and the testimony of its earliest members. By this means, the current members wish to express their appreciation for the vision and investments of more than 1000 men and women who have developed this organization and its facilities for the benefit of future generations of sportsmen.

Often, written history reflects a blending of facts and legends. To the extent possible, this record includes facts obtained from surviving documents. However, a more complete telling of the story must rely on the memories of those involved. All of these memories are a valuable part of this narrative.

Excerpts from the Notes on the History of New Carlisle Sportsmen's Club

1961-62: Charles "Chuck" Stroud, president

Sep 19, 1961: The State of Ohio approved the application of the New Carlisle Sportsmen's Club as a "corporation for non-profit" with an assigned charter number of 303907. James Bagford, Thomas Cook, and Frank Loper, Jr. were named as temporary directors until an election could be held. They, in turn, appointed Charles L. Stroud to serve as agent to respond to any demand served upon the corporation.

Early shooting activities included fox hunting and turkey shoots conducted during cold weather months at the Silver Lake recreational area located a short distance northwest of town. This arrangement was made by brothers Dan and Tom Cook who were associated with the Lake. Turkey shoot targets were simply pieces of paper hung on a rope suspended between two stakes. Shooters used their own guns, but the shells were supplied "to keep it fair."

As space permits, I will publish excerpts from the *Notes on the History of New Carlisle Sportsmen's Club* as compiled by Ron Kaehr.

Pistol Matches (per CMP rules) - 25 yds, 10 shots slow fire in 5 min, 10 shots timed fire (2 groups of 5 shots in 20 sec), 10 shots rapid fire (2 groups of 5 shots in 10 sec). This course of fire is shot twice, once with a .22 rimfire and once with any centerfire handgun.

Highpower Rifle Matches (per CMP rules) - 200 yds, 10 shots slow fire standing in 10 min, 10 shots rapid fire sitting in 60 sec, 10 shots rapid fire prone in 70 sec, and 10 shots slow fire prone in 10 min.
