### More from *Notes on the History of New Carlisle Sportsmen's Club*:

- 1970 Constructed a three bay, 24'x36' closed metal pole building for equipment.
- 1970 Robert Wilkerson remembers that he and Bob Minton put up the large sign at the front of the property. The sign was donated by Carl Barnhart from the old Chevy dealership in New Carlisle. Robert fashioned the letters for the Club's name from stainless steel.
- 1971 Tax return shows total income of \$12,075 of which \$11,248 came from "ham and turkey card shoots," \$590 from member dues, and \$215 from being in the Dept of Agriculture Soil Bank. Number of members – 50.
- 1971 Mar 11 Mortgage cancelled.
- 1972-73 Dick Schildknecht, president (The following entries from minutes supplied by Dick.)
- 1972 Approximately 48 members. The Club participated in several community outreach efforts—Camping Show at the Upper Valley Mall; Trout Derby at Reid Park; first National Hunting and Fishing Day; New Carlisle Festival; and the Coon Skin Cap Brigade.
- 1972 Oct Membership voted to allow participation of women in Club activities.
- 1973 Voted to limit membership to 80 members.
- 1973 Mar Drainage problem discussed at executive committee meeting. President Dick Schildknecht suggested constructing a pond to control the water while using the excavated dirt to develop a backstop for a firing range.
