Any rifle includes Modern Military, Garand, Springfield or Vintage Military (as defined by CMP rules) is 3 positions (slow prone, rapid prone & offhand), 30 rounds + sighters. Carbine is 4 positions (slow prone, rapid prone, rapid sitting & offhand), 40 rounds + sighters. M-1 Garand and Springfield/Vintage is 3 positions, 30 rounds + sighters. Highpower is 4 positions, 40 rounds + sighters. 22 RF Any Sight is 40 rounds, fired prone + unlimited sighters. 25 yard Pistol is .22 and center fire, slow fire, timed fire, and rapid fire, 10 rounds each. All Saturday matches begin at 9:00, signup at 8:30. Sunday afternoon matches begin at 1:00pm with signup at 12:30.
